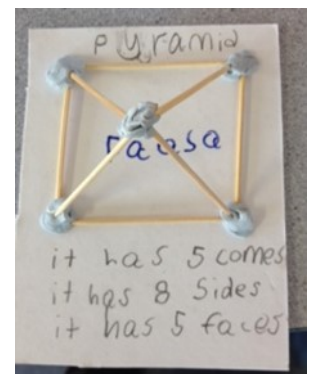
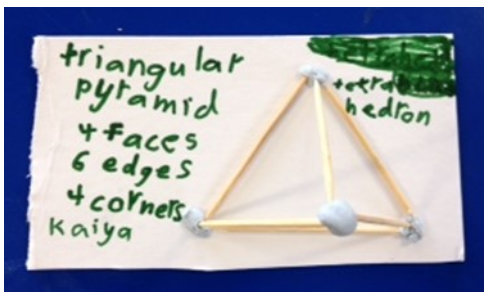
R15 Garden to Table Poems

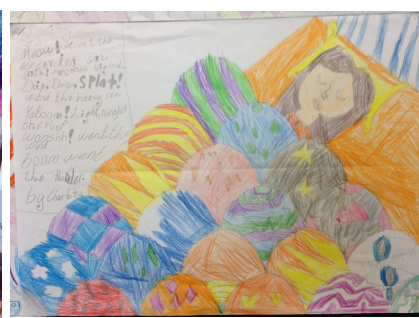
Gorgeous Geometry Room 15 has been exploring the properties of 3D-shapes.
