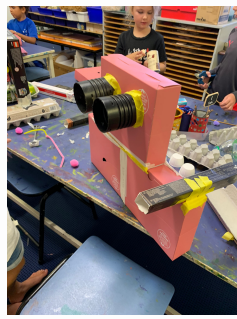
- The Colour Run is on Sunday 24 March

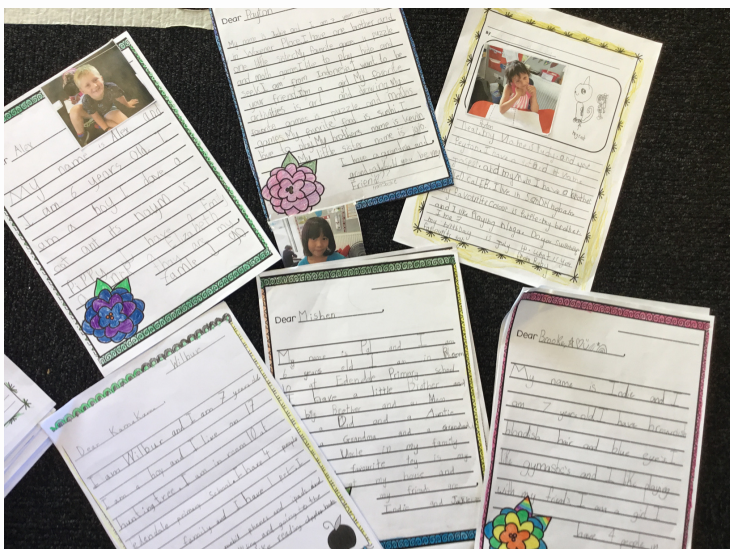
