Tēnā koutou katoa,

Welcome back to Term 3, the penultimate term of the year. This is always a busy and exciting term for teachers and students as they build on students' successes and look at where to next to further enhance their learning. Later on this term whānau will be receiving a progress report outlining the students' learning across the wider curriculum as well as identifying some next teaching steps for Reading, Writing and Mathematics. This report will be followed by Parent Teacher conferences on 24th and 25th of September.

In Week 5 Edendale will be having our Education Review Office review. ERO is a New Zealand government department that evaluates and reports on the education and care of students in school. This will take most of the week and a couple of review officers will be floating around school during that week looking at our school's systems and practices.

This term we also have some fantastic student teachers with us: Ashleigh (Rm 26), Christopher (Rm 33), Yashika (Rm 3) and 'Ana (Rm 28). They are in full control for a number of weeks and we welcome their enthusiasm and passion and wish them all the best for this final placement.

This year we will not be taking part in ICAS assessments. There have been significant changes to ICAS assessments. They are now based exclusively on-line. This has implications for schools that do not have 1:1 devices for students. Whilst we are not offering the ICAS assessments in 2019, we have an Assessment Working Group reviewing current practice and we will be looking at options for 2020.

- **6th August:** The Year 6 students will go to Kowhai Intermediate for an open morning to get a feel for this school
- **7th August:** Balmoral Intermediate open day 9:15am 12:15pm, open evening 6:00pm 7:30pm
- **9th August:** A national day of support for principals during their collective bargaining with the Ministry as they seek to have parity with their secondary colleagues.

- 13th August: From 8:20am 9:20am there is an opportunity to meet the Senior Leadership Team in the staffroom
- **13th August:** From 9:30am-10:30am there is a new parent morning tea for new parents. This provides parents an opportunity to meet the senior leaders and to make connections with other new parents in the community
- Week 9: Zero to Hero week focusing on low emissions travel and zero waste lunches.
- 24th and 25th September Parent Teacher conferences

Finally, congratulations to Katrina, Suzie and Nik who have recently won permanent positions at Edendale. We look forward to continuing to work together.




