This is also managed by Watershed and the contractor is Grossart Water Solutions. Once that is through we can get started on that project also and we will inform you of dates.

Both of these projects have involved countless meetings between the Board, our project manager, architect, and various contractors over many months so it is very rewarding to get to this point.

Whānau engagement

Following on from our Māori hui in Week 10 of Term 1, as reported on in our last Board newsletter, our Board members Annie Ualesi and Stanley Findlay together with Jonathan Ramsay, Jonathan Jackson and Bhairavi Vara, hosted an evening at the end of last term to better understand what's important for Edendale's Pasifika learners and families. Amongst the discussion topics were ways of improving learning outcomes, making stronger connections with the school and each other, and reflecting cultural values, beliefs, practices and wisdoms reflected in the school curriculum. We are grateful to the families who have offered to work with us to create an action plan so that we can put some of these ideas into practice.
